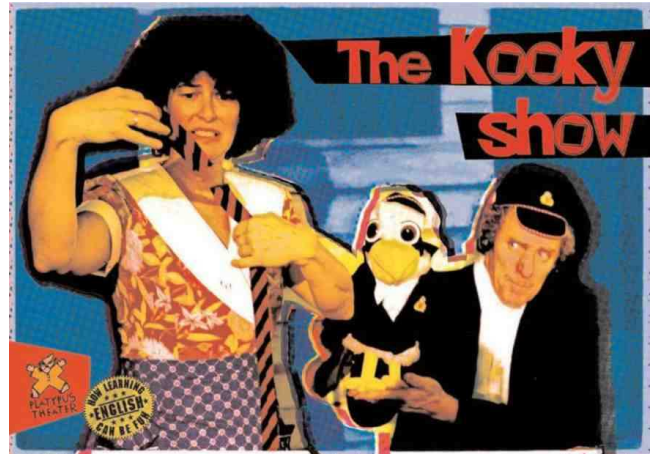




Liebe Kinder,

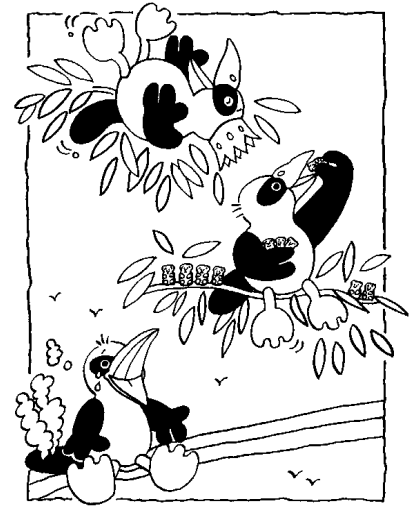
KOOKY SITS ON AN OLD GUM TREE
