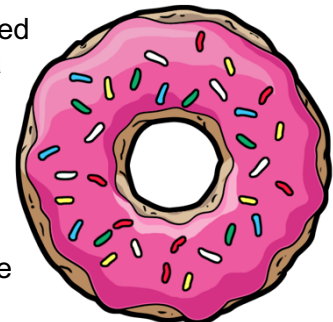

1. Characters in the story

Food Fight is a fictive gameshow that takes place in the future, in the year 2100. Contestants are fighting for food. The contestants battle it out, in a series of food-related quiz questions and physical challenges, to win a giant box of real food.

Subsifood is a huge company that produces Subsifood pills that feed every human of the planet. The pills provide all the nutrients a human needs in order to survive. Real food barely exists because the earth's soil got killed due to pollution, water shortages and climate change.

Danny Donut is the host of the long running game show, Food Fight. His catchphrase is “And that’s how the donut rolls”. The gameshow is sponsored by a company called Subsifood.



Zima is a contestant in the show. She has never tried real food. She is a schoolgirl and an influencer with almost 3 million followers.

Angelica Abricot is Zima’s Grandma. She will soon celebrate her 100th birthday. She has a robot dog called Rover. She has connections with the activist group, Food 4 All.

Skip is a contestant in the show. He is a dumpster diver. He searches through dumpsters for sport and to find objects that might be valuable or of interest. He reveals that he sometimes finds food.

JJ is a contestant in the show. She is an entrepreneur who wants to win the show so she can make a lot of money with her company called Foodle.

Martina is a contestant in the show. She is an ex-chef who misses cooking and eating real food. She wants to grow her own food if she wins the show.

 - o Names for each character for example Angelica Apricot, Danny Donut, ...
 - o What is their personality like? What job to they have? How old are they? How do they act? Why are they in the gameshow? ...
 - o Make an introduction for your character
- 5-8 quiz questions to ask the contestants
- Option: 1 physical challenge for example an egg and spoon race
- Who wins the show?
