What to do now? What do you think will happen?

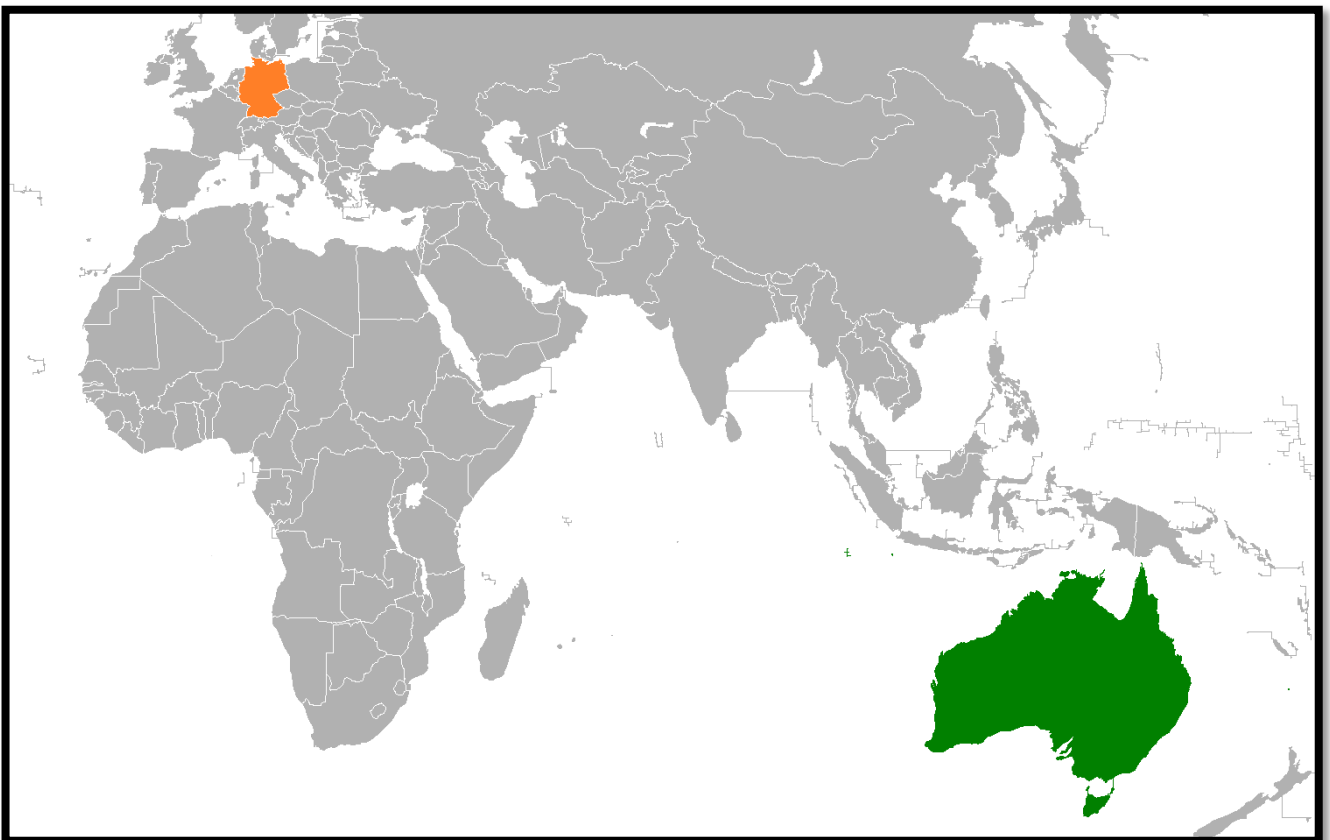
Lucy is eleven years old. She has a lot of energy. She like to play games.

What other countries can you see on the map? Find out how to say them in English.






