ROLL UP
ONE OR TWO
SOCKS AND
PUT IT INSIDE
THE OTHER
ONE TO MAKE
THE HEAD.



3.
TIE A STRING
AROUND
THE SOCK
TO MAKE
THE NECK



4.
CUT 6-8 LEGS
WITH
SCISSORS.
GLUE OR
SEW ON
BUTTONS
FOR THE
FACE.



5.
AND NOW
YOU HAVE
YOUR OWN
SOCKTOPUS
FRIEND
